These conditions qualify for waiver because studies would be impossible or highly impractical.

actinic keratosis	giant cell arteritis
acute bacterial exacerbations of chronic bronchitis (a complication of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease)	gout
adjunctive treatment of major depressive disorder	heavy menstrual bleeding associated with uterine fibroids
age-related macular degeneration (AMD)	Huntington's chorea
Alzheimer's disease amyloidosis	idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis
amyotrophic lateral sclerosis	infertility & reproductive technology (including Assisted Reproductive Technology (ART))
androgenic alopecia	memory loss
atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease (excluding genetic causes and including acute myocardial infarction due to ASCD)	menopause and perimenopausal disorders
benign monoclonal gammopathy	mesothelioma
benign prostatic hyperplasia	microscopic polyangiitis
bullous pemphigoid	myelodysplasia
cancer:	myelofibrosis & myeloproliferative disorders
basal cell and squamous cell skin cancer	Myopic Choroidal Neovascularization (mCNV)
bladder; breast; cervical; colorectal	opioid induced constipation in chronic, non-cancer pain
cholangiocarcinoma	osteoarthritis
endometrial	overactive bladder
esophageal	Parkinson's disease
fallopian tube	paroxysmal nocturnal hemoglobinuria
follicular lymphoma	plasma cells and antibody production disorders
gastric	polycythemia vera
hairy cell leukemia	polymyalgia rheumatica (PMR)
hepatocellular	postmenopausal osteoporosis
indolent non-Hodgkin lymphoma	presbyopia
liposarcoma	prevention of stroke and systemic embolic events in atrial fibrillation
lung (small & non-small cell)	reduction of thrombotic cardiovascular events in patients with coronary artery disease
multiple myeloma	replacement therapy in males for conditions associated with a deficiency or absence of endogenous testosterone
oropharynx (squamous cell)	retinal vein occlusions (RVO)
ovarian (non-germ cell)	rosacea
pancreatic	Sjogren's Syndrome
peritoneal	stress urinary incontinence
prostate	temporary improvement in the appearance of glabellar, canthal, and/or forehead lines
renal cell uterine	thyroid eye disease
chronic lymphocytic leukemia	treatment of incompetent great saphenous veins and varicosities
chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)	treatment of Hypoactive Sexual Desire Disorder (HSDD) in postmenopausal women
cryoglobulinemia	type 2 diabetic mellitus with cardiovascular disease
degenerative intervertebral disc disease	type 2 diabetic nephropathy
diabetic foot infections	vascular dementia/vascular cognitive disorder/impairment
