GRAS or Approved Food Additive Available in the Food Supply

Used as a
Dietary
Ingredient
without
Chemical
Alteration



GRAS or Approved Food Additive



- GRAS Notifications
- Independent GRAS Conclusion
- Food Additive Petition



Available in the Food Supply



- Legally marketed (anywhere in the world) and
- Has been introduced into the food supply



Used as a Dietary Ingredient without Chemical Alteration



- Process that does not result in chemical alteration
 - Involves only physical steps (e.g., water extraction and condensation); and
 - Does not selectively increase the concentration of particular active ingredients or cause a chemical reaction (other than esterification) that would modify the covalent bonds of any substance in the original material
