

Protection for Agricultural Field Workers During the COVID-19 Pandemic

Masks and Frequent Hygiene Measures

- Wearing a mask helps reduce the spread of COVID-19.
- Everyone should wear a mask correctly.
 It should cover your nose and mouth and be changed frequently.
- Everyone should frequently wash their hands or use a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.






Protection Against COVID-19 in Agriculture Work Sites

- Place safety and informational posters about COVID-19 in places that are visible to your workers.
- The posters should indicate safety measures: wearing a mask, staying at least 6 feet apart, handwashing, and avoiding crowds and poorly ventilated areas.
- Encourage your workers to get vaccinated. COVID-19 vaccines are safe and available, regardless of your immigration or health insurance status.

What to Do If Someone Is Sick

- Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms should stay at home and isolated from everyone else with whom they share housing.
- The employer should communicate worker's positive COVID-19 cases to local health authorities.
