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At the ninth PDUFA Negotiation meeting, FDA and Industry discussed draft commitment language for the Data/IT Modernization proposal in addition to the required cost of funding for projects and resources. FDA and Industry expressed their alignment on the IT Modernization draft commitment language and priority and agreed to integrate CBER IT Modernization into it. FDA noted that IT modernization efforts were enterprise-wide and with the objective to promote consistent application of capabilities across the agency. FDA and Industry discussed PDUFA funding for modernizationrelated efforts, cloud initiatives, and resources, with FDA highlighting the fact that majority of its present IT investments are allocated toward operation and maintenance costs. FDA and Industry agreed to continue their discussion of the IT Modernization commitments at the next meeting.
