Dear Dr. Alverson:

The purpose of this letter is to notify the Alabama State Board of Pharmacy (BOP) that the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) does not intend to take further action with regard to an inspection of a pharmacy licensed by the Alabama BOP, Service First Pharmacies, Inc. dba Madison Drugs, located at 8 Parade Street NW, Suite 100, Huntsville, Alabama 35806-4847 (Community Pharmacy License #106455).

FDA inspected the firm from March 7, 2017, to March 8, 2017. The Alabama BOP was informed of the inspection, but did not accompany FDA investigators during the inspection. No Form FDA 483 was issued to the firm.

During the inspection, the FDA investigators reviewed a small sample of records for products compounded by Service First Pharmacies, Inc. dba Madison Drugs and determined, based on this sample, that this firm appears to obtain valid prescriptions for individually-identified patients for the drug products that it compounds and distributes. After review of the records, FDA does not intend to take further action with regard to the findings of this inspection at this time and FDA believes that the firm's compounding practices can be appropriately overseen by the State. Please notify us if you become aware of any adverse events or product quality concerns associated with drugs made at this facility, or if you observe any practices at this facility that concern you or that could be violations of Federal law.
