

Rita F. Redberg, M.D., M.Sc., F.A.C.C.

Dr. Rita F. Redberg is a cardiologist and Professor of Medicine at the University of California, San Francisco since 1990 and Core Faculty, Philip R Lee Institute for Health Policy Studies.

She is the Chief Editor of *JAMA Internal Medicine* and has spearheaded the journal's new focus on health care reform and "less is more", which highlights areas of health care with no known benefit and definite risks. Her research interests are in the areas of health policy and technology assessment, and how to promote high value care, focusing on high risk medical devices as well as the need for inclusion of women in clinical trials of such devices.

Dr. Redberg has given Congressional testimony multiple times in hearings related to the issue of balancing safety and innovation in medical device approvals. She worked in the office of Senator Orrin Hatch and with the Senate Judiciary Committee on FDA-related matters during her tenure as a Robert Wood Johnson Health Policy Fellow, 2003-2006.
