

Instructions on How to Comment on Standards for the Growing, Harvesting, Packing, and Holding of Produce for Human Consumption Relating to Agricultural Water; Proposed Rule

Comment Period Ends on April 5, 2022 Docket Number: FDA-2021-N-0471

In the Federal Register of January 6, 2022, the FDA announced two public meetings and request for comments to engage with stakeholders and invite input on the Proposed Rule: Standards for the Growing, Harvesting, Packing, and Holding of Produce for Human Consumption Relating to Agricultural Water.

This proposed rule would amend the agricultural water provisions of the produce safety regulation to replace the microbial criteria and testing requirements for preharvest agricultural water for covered produce (other than sprouts) that covered farms have found to be complex and challenging to implement, with provisions for comprehensive assessments of pre-harvest agricultural water systems, practices, and on-farm conditions.

We will consider all comments made at these public meetings or received through the docket.

The public comments are due APRIL 5, 2022.
