Types of Infant Formula



Ready-to-feed
Do not add water




Liquid concentrate
Must be mixed with an equal amount of water




Powdered
Must be mixed with water according to label instructions

Did you know?
Many foreign infant formula labels will indicate to sterilize teats, this refers to nipples for baby bottles.



How to Prepare Powdered Infant Formula*



*For specific directions, follow the manufacturers' instructions.

Milliliters to Fluid Ounces

Milliliters	Fluid Ounces	Milliliters	Fluid Ounces
30 mL	1 fl oz	150 mL	5 fl oz
60 mL	2 fl oz	180 mL	6 fl oz
90 mL	3 fl oz	210 mL	7 fl oz
120 mL	4 fl oz	240 mL	8 fl oz

Common conversions from Celsius to Fahrenheit (°C to °F)



0 °C = 32 °F
Freezing point of water



37 °C = 98.6 °F
Average human body temperature



100 °C = 212 °F
Boiling point of water
